

Travel Support Report Tips

When writing your travel report (aim for about 1-2 pages), you should discuss your experience attending and presenting at your conference. Consider what aspects were the most helpful in developing your understanding of your field of interest. **The following list provides some possible questions to consider when writing your report.** However, note that this is not an exhaustive list of possible aspects to discuss. If there is a particular issue that is not included in this list that you believe is important, please feel free to include it! 1. What activities, workshops, or sessions did you participate in at the conference? If so, what did you learn?
2. What did you learn from presenting your research?
3. How did you network and did these opportunities give insight into future research or job/internship opportunities?
5. How did your experience shape your perception of the field?
6. Overall, what are your main takeaways from this experience?
